1062 votes were cast at the town hall on November 8th, 2016. We have 1458 registered voters and 98 voters registered on election day. In addition, there were many residents voting absentee.

The presidential election resulted in 703 votes for Trump/Pence and 279 for Clinton/Kaine. Voters re-elected Mark Olson and Keith Quale to town supervisor positions.

The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether property in the jurisdiction has been properly valued and classified by the assessor. If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the value or classification after discussing it with the assessor, you may appear before the local board of appeal and equalization. The board will review your assessments and may make corrections as needed. Generally, you must appeal to the local board before appealing to the county board of appeal and equalization.
